

# LAZY MAY

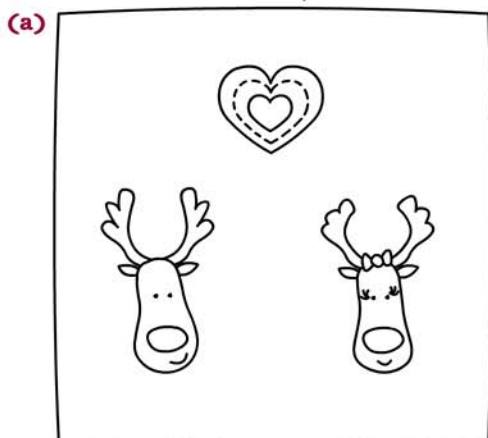
## reindeer christmas decorations

this tutorial will show you how to make some super cute decorations to hang on your tree.

### To make the set of three you will need

Lazy May reindeer PDF patterns  
1 x 10" square plain cotton  
4 x 6" square dark green felt  
2 x 4" square pink felt  
embroidery thread in a variety of colours

3 x 6" of gold ribbon  
coloured crayons  
glitter  
glue  
needle, pins, scissors, pen



1. Transfer the reindeer and heart patterns to your cotton using the method shown on the Lazy May 'PDF to fabric guide', found on the How2 page (a).

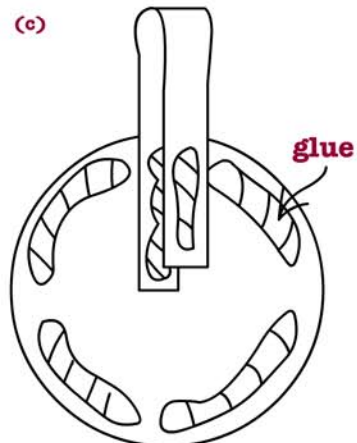
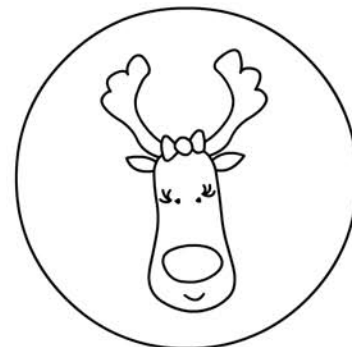
2. Embroider over your transferred lines, I used a back stitch for the out lines and a brick stitch to fill in the antlers and bow, you could also use a satin stitch.

3. Now shade the faces and noses using the crayons, then cut out the reindeers and heart individually leaving a gap of around 3mm

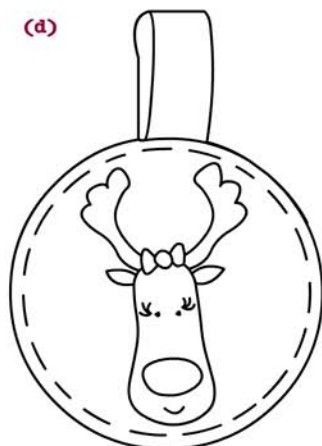
4. Next stack your four pieces of green felt and secure with a pin. Find a glass or mug that when you draw around it creates a circle bigger than your reindeer. Draw around the mug or glass and trim the felt stack in to a circle. Do the same for the heart using your pink felt, but this time with a smaller glass.

5. Take two of the green circles and glue a reindeer in the centre of each one (b). Take one of the pink circles and glue the heart in the centre.

6. Fold your ribbon in half and glue it as shown (c) to one of the unused green felt circles. Apply more glue as shown and then place the circle with the reindeer on top to make a sandwich. Push them together then repeat with the second reindeer and the heart design.

7. Sew around the edge of the felt sandwiches using a contrasting colour like pink and some big running stitches (d).

8. Finally add some glittery spots by putting small dabs on glue on the felt and sprinkling over glitter, shake off the excess and your done.
